

D'VINE WHIMSY CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- *Strips cut across the width of fabric will be abbreviated as WOF unless otherwise noted.
 - *For this quilt all long strips greater than WOF are cut from the length of fabric or LOF. Open fabric and refold end to end to make cutting long strips easier. (I trim selvages before measuring and cutting strips).
 - *Stack cut strips so selvedge edges are even, and then trim off selvages. (When cutting WOF)
 - *Always measure and cut individual strips from a trimmed edge. (When cutting WOF)
 - *All seams are sewn with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.
 - *Label each set of strips and pieces with masking tape as you cut to avoid confusion later. Clip sets together.
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COLOR 1 – (2 3/8 yds or 85.5 inches)

Please note: if you are making the smaller quilt but do not want to piece the long strips together you will need to follow the yardage and cutting instructions for the large quilt.

Cutting instructions for Large quilt: Color 1

Cut (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF strips. From these strips:

Cut (2) $77\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label and clip together. Set aside for outside border.

Cut (2) $63\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label and clip together. Set aside for outside border.

Save left over pieces for later instructions.

Cut (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF strips.

From one strip cut (1) $64\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1) $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From one strip cut (1) $64\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1) $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From one strip cut (1) $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1) $35\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From one strip cut (1) $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1) $35\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From one strip cut (1) $42\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1) $41\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From one strip cut (1) $27\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, (1) $21\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, (2) $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From one strip cut (6) $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

From one strip cut (1) $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (13) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Cut the remaining (3) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from one of the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces left over from cutting the long strips listed above.

*Please note: make sure you cut a total of *nine* $13\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and *eighteen* $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from the above strips.

You should have a 12 inch width left over after cutting all your strips. Save this and set aside with rest of the left over pieces for later instructions.

Cutting instructions for Small quilt: Color 1

Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. From these strips:

Open, stack and crosscut (6) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label and set aside for later instructions.

Cut (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew (2) strips together end to end. Press seam.

Then cut (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Make 2. From left over strips cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew (2) strips together end to end. Press seam.

Then cut (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Make 2. From left over strips cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (10) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. From these strips

Cut (1) $42\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (1) $41\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (1) $27\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (1) $21\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

Cut (9) $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Cut (18) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

You should have a 9 inch width left over after cutting your strips. Save this and set aside for later instructions.

Color 2 – (7/8 yd / 31 1/2") or (5/8 yd / 22 1/2")

Cutting Instructions for Large quilt

Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips.

Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

From (1) 4 1/2" strip, open and cut (1) 4 1/2" x 28 1/2" strip.

From (1) 4 1/2" strip, open and cut (1) 4 1/2" x 21" and (1) 4 1/2" x 18 1/2" strip. Trim this piece to 3 1/2" x 18 1/2".

From (1) 2 1/2" strip, open and cut (1) 2 1/2" x 27 1/2" strip, and (3) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From (1) 2 1/2" strip cut (9) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips

From (1) 2 1/2" strip cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

Set aside the remaining fabric for later instructions.

COLOR 3 – (5/8 yd) or (1/4 yd)

Set aside for later instructions

COLOR 4 – (1/8 yd) for Large and Small quilt

Set aside for later instructions

COLOR 5 – (1 5/8" yd) or (5/8 yd)

Cutting instructions for long un-pieced strip: color 5

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF Strip

Cut (2) 2 1/2" x LOF Strips

From (1) 6 1/2" strip, open and cut (1) 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle from one end.

From remaining 6 1/2" strip left from step 1, cut (1) 4 1/2" x 14" piece.

From (1) 2 1/2" strip, cut (1) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" strip.

From (1) 2 1/2" strip, cut (1) 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" strip.

Cutting instructions if piecing long strip: color 5

Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. From (2) 2 1/2" strips:

Open strips and sew end to end. Measure sewn strip and cut (1) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" strip.

From remaining 2 1/2" strip: open and Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" strip.

From remaining fabric

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" piece.

Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 14" piece.

COLOR 6 – (4 yds = 144") or (1 1/2 yds = 54")

Cutting instructions for Large quilt:

Cut (2) 13 1/2" x LOF strips. From these strips:

Cut (2) 13 1/2" x 77 1/2" strips. Label and clip together. Set aside for outside border.

Cut (2) 13 1/2" x 63 1/2" strips. Label and clip together. Set aside for outside border.

From remaining fabric:

Cut (1) 14 1/2" x 73" strip. From this strip cut:

(5) 14 1/2" x 14 1/2" squares. Label and clip together.

From remaining fabric:

Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 28 1/2" strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 21" strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 14" strip

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strip, (9) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips, (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares, and (3) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.

Cutting instructions for Small quilt: Color 6

Cut (3) 14 ½" x WOF strip

Crosscut (6) 14 ½" x 14 ½" background squares. You only need 5 of them. Set sixth square aside for now.

Cut (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips.

From one strip:

Cut: (1) 4 ½" x 28 ½" strip and (1) 4 ½" x 14" piece.

From the second strip:

Cut: (1) 4 ½" x 21" piece and (1) 3 ½" x 18 ½" piece. *You will need to trim 1 inch long edge of the 4 ½" x 18 ½" strip in order to get the 3 ½" x 18 ½" piece.*

From remaining fabric and the left over background square

Cut: (9) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, (12) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares, and (3) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares.

COLOR 7 – (1/8 yd) for Large and Small quilts

Set aside for later instructions.

COLOR 8 – (5/8 yd) for Large and Small quilts

Cut (21) 4 ½" x 6 ½" pieces.

COLOR 9 – (1/8 yd) for Large and Small quilts

Set aside for later instructions.

COLOR 10 – (Small scrap black) for Large and Small quilts

COLOR 11 – (3/8 yd) Large quilt or (1/4 yd) Small quilt

This is for your binding.
